The Rev. Dr. Glossie H. Valentine Ministry Scholarship is a one-time \$1,000 scholarship to support active members of Zion Baptist Church who are students entering college, currently in college, entering graduate school or currently in graduate school who plan to study ministry, religion, divinity or related major. Note the College Ministry has sole discretion to determine studies that are not specifically listed above that also may be eligible. Support for this scholarship is provided by the family in the memory of Rev. Dr. Glossie H. Valentine, who went home to be with the Lord on July 28, 2018, at 86 years of age. She was a member of Zion Baptist Church for over 50 years and a resident of Detroit, Michigan at the time of passing.

Eligibility Requirements

The Applicant must:

- ⇒ be an active member of Zion Baptist Church
- ⇒ be a graduating high school senior enrolled to attend college, a current college student, a student entering graduate school or a current graduate school student
- ⇒ attach a copy of the acceptance letter from the college or university that he/she plans to attend (for high school students and entering graduate students) or attach a copy of most recent college transcript (for current college or graduate school students)
- ⇒ list the specific, intended ministry course of study in college or graduate school
- ⇒ submit two letters of recommendation: one from an official school representative (Principal, Dean, Counselor, Teacher, Professor, Advisor, etc.) and one from a ministry leader, teacher, Pastor, etc., who has knowledge of your interest in ministry
- ⇒ submit a wallet sized recent photograph
- ⇒ *submit an essay, not to exceed 300 words, addressing the topic, "Why the ministry is important to communities and why it is important to me." You should cite examples of your intended course of study, how you have grown as a result of your pursuit of the ministry and how you plan to use your studies to aid the community.*
Your essay must be typewritten (prepared on a computer), double spaced and presented on plain white paper. Please use correct grammar and check your spelling
- ⇒ return the complete application and attachments to Zion Baptist Church by hand delivery or U.S. Mail on or before noon on Sunday, May 12, 2019.

- ⇒ Acknowledge receipt of award via a written note of appreciation to The Rev. Dr. Glossie H. Valentine Ministry Scholarship at Zion Baptist Church
